- Eligibility:** Athletes are eligible to compete if they are members of the club they are registered with. All swimmers in good standing within their respective teams and schools are eligible to compete. Each team will define the rules of membership and ensure that each participating athlete is a member in good standing with their respective team.
- Location:** Norris Aquatics Center (in Henry Crown Sports Pavilion)

Northwestern University, Evanston, IL
- Facility:** An Olympic size pool set-up in short course configuration with eight 25-yard competition lanes. Warm-up lanes will be available for the duration of the meet.
- Parking:** Please use the parking garage attached to the Henry Crown Sports Pavilion and Norris Aquatics Center. Use the “A” elevator bank to access the facility. Parking is free on weekends.
- Deck Area:** All swimmers are permitted on the deck. It is recommended that all spectators remain on the bleachers and away from the blocks. Deck is wheelchair accessible. There is an admission fee of \$5 for spectators.
- Timing:** Colorado timing system.
- Warmup:** 12:30 pm CST.
Start: 1:30 pm CST.
- Entry Limit:** Four individual events per swimmer, no cap on relays.
- Deadlines:** Please submit all entries by **Friday, Jan. 17th at 5:00pm**. Hy-Tek/Team Manager format is preferred, but we will accept Excel spreadsheets.

Fees: **\$10/swimmer with Hy-Tek submission, \$12/swimmer with Excel. Capped at \$300 maximum per team.** Please pay in a check made out to **Northwestern University** with **“Swim Club”** in the memo line or Venmo @NUILswimclub.

Late Entries: Late entries will not be accepted and changes to existing line up will only be accepted up until 12 AM (midnight) on Tuesday, January 28th, 2020.

Meeting: There will be a team representative meeting 15 minutes before the start of competition (1:15pm).

Scoring: Scoring will be based on results from timed finals. Only the top 3 individual places and top 2 relay places from each team will be scored.
Individual Events: 10-8-7-6-4-3-2-1
Relay Events: 20-16-14-12-8-6-4-2

Awards: Winners of each event will receive a random type of rubber duck! Top three scoring teams will also receive special ducks.

Food: There will be a concession stand selling Gatorade and protein bars. Athletes and coaches are allowed to bring refreshments and coolers into the pool area only. NO GLASS or ALCOHOL is allowed within the facility.

Events: Events will run in the order of women, then men. There will two ten-minute breaks, one following the men’s 50 Free and the other following the men’s 25 Free.
